## Functional Behaviour Assessment of Challenging Behaviour in Children and Youth with Autism Spectrum Disorders

**PARTICIPANTS  
NEEDED**

The purpose of this research project is to compare three questionnaires that are commonly used to determine the possible reasons why a particular challenging behaviour (e.g. aggression, self-injury, disruptive behaviour) occurs.

We are looking for parents who have a child

- between the ages of 5 and 18
- who has been diagnosed with an Autism Spectrum Disorder (e.g. Autism, Asperger Syndrome)
- who currently engages in aggression, self-injury, or other disruptive behaviours

If you agree to participate in this study, the student investigator or one of the research assistants will schedule an appointment to come to your home at your convenience. At this appointment, you will be asked to complete some questionnaires about your child's behaviour. During this time, the student investigator/research assistant will observe your child and gather information on your child's behaviour. It is anticipated that the visit will take no longer than 2 hours of your time.

Participants will be compensated \$50 for their time.
