Intensive Intervention for Autism Using the DIR/Floortime Method

We are currently seeking motivated parents who are interested in providing intensive DIR/Floortime intervention for their child with autism.

What is the cost?

- The service is **FREE** to participants. We ask only that you and your child contribute to the study by permitting us to evaluate your child's progress while receiving treatment.

What are the basic requirements?

- Your child must have a formal diagnosis of an autistic spectrum disorder from a qualified professional and be between 2 and 4 years of age.
- You and/or your family members must be willing and able to attend training sessions to learn how to help your child develop through Floortime.
- You and/or your family members must be willing and able to spend approximately 30 hours each week interacting with your child according to the Floortime method.

How do I sign up?

- At this time, we can provide therapy for only a limited number of children. To sign up, please call our research coordinator at 416 736 2100 x 20401. Participants will be chosen randomly from the pool of qualified applicants.
