When she started to research her daughter's options once she graduates from High School, she found that their options were very limited. After researching and speaking with other parents in the same predicament, she realized that once our children graduate they are on their own, they had no where productive to go. Many parents would have to either quit their jobs to stay home or burden their families with the care for their Adult Child. The need for a Day Program was clear and hence the creation of Tania's Place. **There has to be life after school.**
