



- Data was collected I-5 years post-treatment
- 53 of 82 potential subjects
 - 64% response rate
- No significant differences between participants and nonparticipants at baseline
- Mean age at follow-up:
 - 17.5 years old
 - II.4 grade level
- Mean time to follow-up:
 - 29 months





















