Autism-AS profile

- Social skills: free of social rules
- Communication abilities: verbal and nonverbal
- Theory of Mind: different ways of thinking?
- Consent
- Emotions: detecting, reading, expressing
- Routines
- Sensory issues
- Lack of information/education
- Co-occurring conditions



Issues of Development

- Sexual behaviours:
 - self-stimulation
 - exploring sexuality
- Frustrations and inappropriate behaviours
- Gender identity & role definition:
 - 'My way'
 - flexibility, conflict, and confusion
- Social imitation:
 - context, consent



Factors Influencing Social & Sexual Development

(Griffiths, 1999)

- Information
- Limitations of the environment
- Gender segregation
- Internet & pornography



Factors Influencing Social & Sexual Development

- Intimacy
 - Interests and limits
 - Private and public setting
- Exploration and positive experiences



Puberty

- Physiological changes
 - Hormones levels (testosterone, estrogen)
 - Body changes: body hair, sexual function, reactions, periods, etc.
- Psychological changes
 - Emotions (mood changes, stronger, cycle)
 - Independence
 - Curiosity
 - Interests



Puberty

- Recognition of abusive/unfriendly relationships
- Dangerous relationship
- Qualities of a healthy relationship
 - Sharing
 - Communication
 - Pleasure, interest
 - Respect, communication and much more...









Love & Affection
