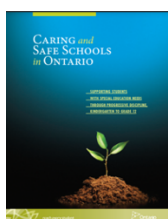

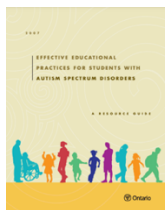

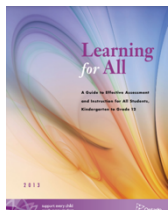
[Caring and Safe Schools in Ontario: Supporting students with special education needs through progressive discipline, kindergarten to Grade 12](#)

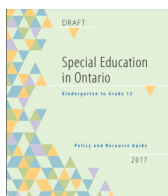
