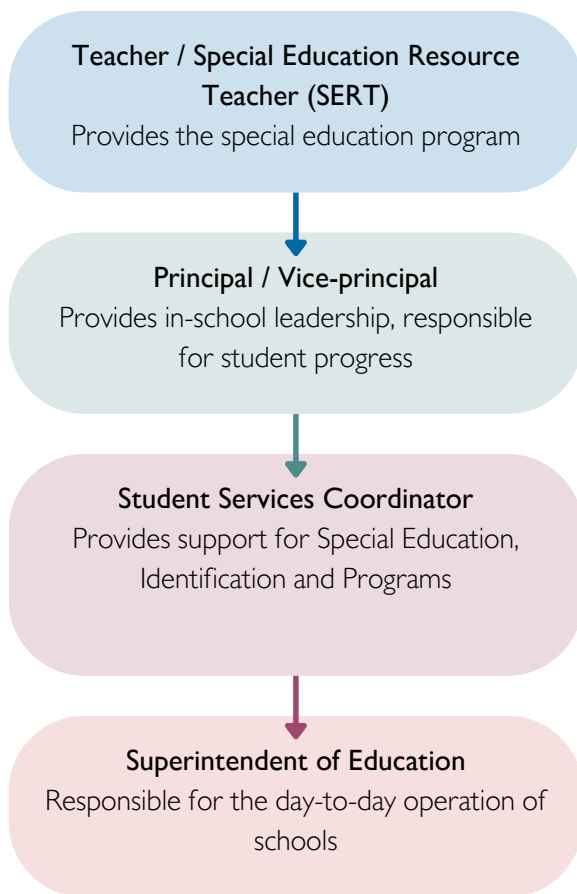


Steps to Navigating School Communication: Who to Talk and When

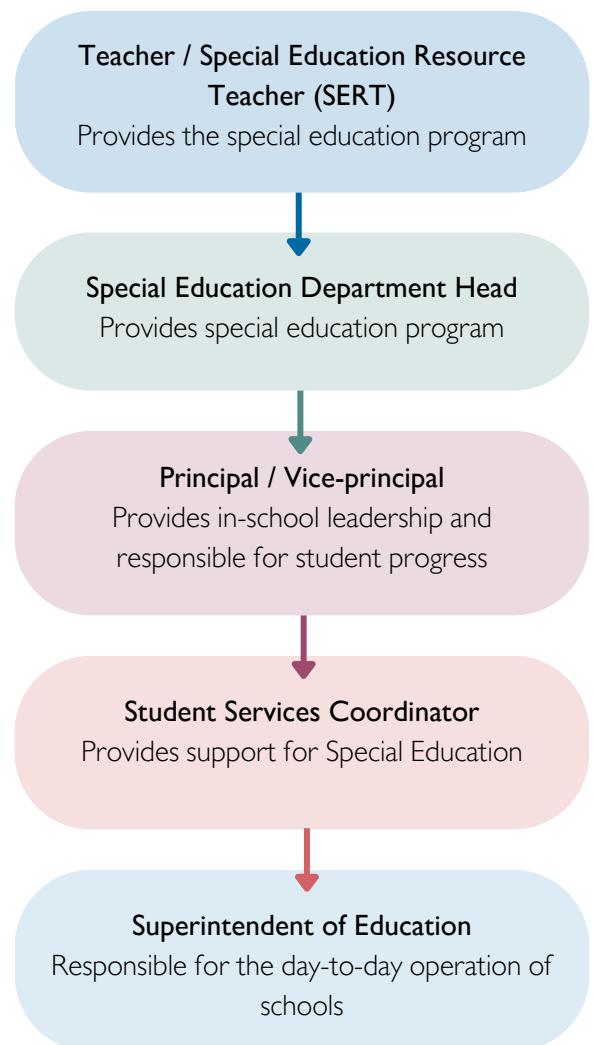
Open communication with the school team helps build a positive relationship. Working together will help keep everyone focused on what is in the best interests of your child.

If you have questions or concerns about the supports and services your child is receiving at school, follow the steps in the consultation sequence below. This process is recommended by school boards. By starting with the school team members who work most closely with your child, you will help build a positive relationship and, most importantly, find the quickest solution. Follow the steps in order to reduce delays.
